

Time required by the Commission to carry out certain stages of the qualification assessment for the position compliance with respect to one judge

The calculation is based on data collected during the qualification assessment assigned by the Commission on October 20, 2017, for 999 judges

It takes the Commission 24 hours 55 minutes to carry out the qualification assessment with respect to each judge.

To assess 1000 judges the Commission needs to spend about 24,916 hours.

It takes the Commission about 9 hours to form, scan, depersonify and publish on the official website the dossier of each judge subject to the qualification assessment
